

# THE ENOCH SOLAR CALENDAR

## Combined 364-Day Calendar + Festival Guide

*Based on the Spring Equinox (Tequphah)*

---

## 1. STRUCTURE OF THE 364-DAY YEAR

The Enoch Solar Calendar is built on four perfect seasonal quarters:

- **91 days per quarter**
- **13 weeks per quarter**
- **52 Sabbaths per year**
- **364 days each year**

Every season is governed by a **Tequphah** — a seasonal turning — standing alone as one of the four “leaders of the year.”

The **Spring Tequphah (Equinox)** is the anchor of the entire calendar.

The **day after the Equinox** is:

- **Day 1 of the First Month (Abib)**
- **Day 1 of the entire 364-day year**

## 2. THE SEVENTH-DAY SABBATHS OF THE YEAR

*Counted from the Spring Equinox*

These are the fixed Sabbaths of the 364-day year:

**7, 14, 21, 28, 35, 42, 49, 56, 63, 70, 77, 84, 91, 98, 105, 112, 119, 126, 133, 140, 147, 154, 161, 168, 175, 182, 189, 196, 203, 210, 217, 224, 231, 238, 245, 252, 259, 266, 273, 280, 287, 294, 301, 308, 315, 322, 329, 336, 343, 350, 357, 364.**

This is the unbroken Sabbath cycle preserved through Enoch, Jubilees.

# 3. CALENDAR OVERVIEW — FESTIVALS IN THEIR EXACT POSITIONS

Below is a simple combined chart showing the **days of the year** and where every **Festival** and **Sabbath** falls.

---

## **SPRING SEASON (ABIB)**

### **Days 1–91**

**Day 1** – Start of the Year (the day after the Equinox)

### **SABBATHS:**

7, 14, 21, 28, 35, 42, 49, 56, 63, 70, 77, 84

---

## **Festival 1: Passover (Pesach)**

### **Day 14 – TIME OF REST (Begins at Sunset)**

- Lamb slaughtered at the close of the 14th
- Eaten at the going down of the sun
- Nothing to remain until morning
- The morning after Passover = Day 15, Unleavened Bread

**Scriptures:** Exodus 12 | Leviticus 23 | Deut. 16 | Numbers 33

**Messiah fulfilled this timing perfectly.**

## **Festival 2: Unleavened Bread – Day 15 (UB-1)**

### **Day 15 – DAY OF REST**

Begins the 7-day Matzot Festival.  
No leaven for all seven days.

---

## **Festival 3: Unleavened Bread – Day 21 (UB-7)**

### **Day 21 – DAY OF REST**

Last day of the Matzot Festival.

---

## **Festival 4: Shavuot / Pentecost**

### **Day 71 – DAY OF REST**

Count 7 complete weeks from the First Fruits offering.

This is the Festival of First Fruits, the wheat harvest, and the anniversary of major covenant renewal events (Sinai and Acts 2).

### **End of Spring Quarter:**

#### **Day 91 – Seasonal Completion / Sabbath**

## **SUMMER SEASON**

### **Days 92–182**

#### **SABBATHS:**

98, 105, 112, 119, 126, 133, 140, 147, 154, 161, 168, 175

No major festivals occur in summer.

The summer quarter represents the **growing season** — the time when the fruit of righteousness matures.

### **End of Summer Quarter:**

#### **Day 182 – Seasonal Completion / Sabbath**

# FALL SEASON (7th Month: Ěythanim)

**Days 183–273**

**SABBATHS:** 189, 196, 203, 210, 217, 224, 231, 238, 245, 252, 259, 266, 273

This quarter contains **three major fall festivals**.

---

## **Festival 5: Feast of Trumpets (Yum Teru'ah)**

**Day 183 – DAY OF REST**

1st day of the 7th month.

A day of Shofar blasts and awakening.

---

## **Festival 6: Day of Atonement (Yum Kippurim)**

**Day 192 – DAY OF REST & AFFLICTION**

10th day of the 7th month.

Some people complete fast and humbling of the soul. We at The Besorah Seed treat it normal with eating for the festival.

## **Festival 7: Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkoth)**

**Day 197 – DAY OF REST**

Begins the seven-day festival of dwelling in booths.

A festival of joy, gathering, and remembering YAHUAH's provision.

## **Festival 8: The Eighth Day (Last Great Day)**

**Day 204 – DAY OF REST**

The closing assembly of Sukkoth.

A prophetic picture of completion and renewal.

## End of Fall Quarter:

Day 273 – Seasonal Completion / Sabbath

## WINTER SEASON

Days 274–364

### SABBATHS:

280, 287, 294, 301, 308, 315, 322, 329, 336, 343, 350, 357, 364

Winter completes the cycle of the year and prepares for renewal.

## End of Winter Quarter:

Day 364 – Final Sabbath of the Year

The next morning begins a **new cycle**, marked again by the **Spring Tequphah**.

## ★ 4. FULL FESTIVAL TIMELINE (Quick Reference)

Festival	Day of Year	Month	Description
Passover (Pesach)	14	1st Month	Evening sacrifice & meal
UB-1	15	1st Month	First Day of Unleavened Bread
UB-7	21	1st Month	Last Day of Unleavened Bread
Shavuot	71	3rd Month	First Fruits of Wheat
Trumpets	183	7th Month	Day of Blowing
Atonement	192	7th Month	Fast & affliction
Tabernacles (Sukkoth)	197	7th Month	Feast of Dwelling
The Eighth Day	204	7th Month	Last Great Day

ALL FESTIVALS = **Days of Rest**

ALL FESTIVALS = **Shofar Command Days**

ALL TIMING = **Solar, Fixed, Unchanging**

## 5. THE CALENDAR NEVER SHIFTS

Because this is a **solar** calendar:

- Festivals NEVER drift
- Sabbaths NEVER slide into different weekdays
- No leap months are needed
- No lunar corrections are required

It is **perfect**, just as taught by Enoch, Jubilees, and the priestly order.
