

The Calendar of Enoch

1. Origin and Scriptural Authority

1.1 Enoch's Appointed Role

According to *Jubilees 4:16–18*, Enoch was the first man to be taught heavenly knowledge, writing, and wisdom. He recorded:

- The signs of heaven
- The order of the months
- The seasons of the year
- The Sabbaths and divisions of time

Enoch received divine authority to preserve the true solar calendar given by the Creator.

1.2 The True Sign of the Covenant — The Sabbath

Exodus 31:13 identifies the Sabbath as the sign between the Creator and His people.

Scripture never commands a lunar calendar.

The Enoch calendar is based on the solar order and the heavenly lights of *Genesis 1:14*.

2. Foundations of the 364-Day Enoch Calendar

2.1 The Sun's Primacy

Enoch 72:1–4 declares the sun as the “great light” that governs the year.

- The year begins when the sun enters the **Fourth Gate of the East** — the **Spring Equinox (Tequphah)**.

2.2 The Four Leaders of the Seasons

Enoch 82:5 explains that four unique days divide the year.

These are not counted inside the months and align with the Jubilee pattern (*Jubilees 6:23–24*).

2.3 The Stars as Witnesses

Genesis 1:14–15 and *Enoch 75* state that star constellations testify to each season

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2.4 The Calendar's Self-Correcting Design

The system requires no man-made intercalation.

- If equinox occurs → *that* day is the Tequphah

This prevents drift and preserves the 364-day design.

3. The 364-Day Structure and Weekly Rhythm

The year consists of:

- **52 perfect weeks**
- **364 total days**
- **No lunar dependence**
- **Sabbaths always fall on the same days each year**

The year always begins on **Day 1 after the Tequphah**.

4. Appointed Times and Festivals (Based on the PDF Calendar)

Yahuah Enoch Calendar

4.1 Start of the Year

- **Spring Tequphah / Equinox**
- The next day marks **Day 1 of Month 1**
- Sabbath "1" begins 7 days after the equinox division day

4.2 Passover & Unleavened Bread

- **Passover (14 Abib)** always lands on Sabbath 2
- **Unleavened Bread (15–21 Abib)**
- **First Fruits / Wave Sheaf** follows during Week 3

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4.3 Counting to Shavuot (Pentecost)

- Seven Sabbaths complete
- **Shavuot = Appointed Day after Sabbath 10**

4.4 Fall Festivals

- **Yom Teruah / Trumpets** — Month 7, Day 1
 - **Day of Atonement / Yom Kippur** — Month 7, Day 10
 - **Sukkot (Tabernacles)** — Month 7, Days 15–21
 - **The Last Great Day** — Day 22
- These dates are fixed every year due to the 364-day structure.

5. Calendar Layout for (Integrated Summary)

Yahuah Enoch Calendar

The uploaded calendar documents a full cycle from **February 2026 through April 2027**, breaking down all:

- Weekly Sabbaths (1–52)
- Month transitions
- Appointed days
- Scriptural feast timings

- The four seasonal “leader days” stand outside the monthly count.
- All feast days fall predictably each year, demonstrating the calendar’s fixed structure.

6. Messiah and the Enoch Calendar

6.1 The Crucifixion Year Alignment

- Every **8–11 years**, a rare “spring alignment” occurs
 - The solar Enoch calendar briefly aligns with the rabbinic lunar calendar
 - This occurred in **30 AD**, the year of Messiah’s death
- This alignment confirms that the Messiah observed the **Enoch solar calendar**, not the lunar one.

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6.2 Passover and the Weekly Cycle

Messiah died at the close of Sabbath 2 (14 Abib), fulfilling the timing exactly.

6.3 The Resurrection Timing

The resurrection occurred at **sunset** (three days and three nights complete), not at dawn.
The women discovered an already-empty tomb.

7. Wave Sheaf and the First Fruits Resurrection

During the morning of First Fruits:

- The Messiah appeared “as a gardener”
- Because He was performing the **wave sheaf offering**
- Presenting the resurrected saints (Matthew 27:52–53) to the Father

The calendar aligns this event precisely within Week 3 of the year.
