

Yes — the Bible actually reveals **three separate “First-Fruits”** harvests across the year, each tied to one of the **three pilgrim feasts** when all Israel was commanded to appear before Yahuah in Jerusalem.

Let’s look at them side by side:

1. Barley First Fruits

When: Early spring (during Unleavened Bread)

Feast: *Feast of Unleavened Bread / Passover week*

Crop: Barley — the first grain to ripen in Israel

Scripture:

- Leviticus 23:9-14
- Exodus 23:16 (“the feast of the harvest, the first-fruits of thy labours”)

Meaning: The beginning of the harvest — **resurrection and new life.**

→ Messiah’s resurrection aligns here as “the First Fruits of them that slept” (1 Cor 15:20).

2. Wheat First Fruits (Shavuot / Feast of Weeks)

When: Late spring or early summer (7 weeks later)

Feast: *Shavuot / Pentecost*

Crop: Wheat — the main summer harvest

Scripture:

- Leviticus 23:15-21
- Exodus 34:22
- Deuteronomy 16:9-10

Meaning: Completion and fullness — the mature harvest; often linked to the giving of the Torah at Sinai and the outpouring of the Spirit at Pentecost.

3. Fruit / Ingathering First Fruits

When: Autumn (at the end of the agricultural year)

Feast: *Feast of Ingathering / Sukkot (Tabernacles)*

Crop: **Grapes, figs, olives, pomegranates, and other fruits** — the final harvest

Scripture:

- Exodus 23:16 (“...and the Feast of Ingathering, which is in the end of the year...”)
- Deuteronomy 16:13-15

Meaning: Completion and gathering-in — the great harvest of all nations; prophetically the final redemption and rest in the Kingdom.
